Dario Travas, born in 1964 and trained as an architect at the Technical University of Zagreb, has been the Studio Head (Architecture/Design) of the Vienna office of ATP Architects and Engineers since 2005. A native of Croatia he worked from 1991 to 2004 as a design architect for a series of well-known Viennese architectural offices. Since 2007 Travas has also been Managing Director of the Zagreb office of ATP Architects and Engineers where he was responsible for, amongst other things, Croatia's largest shopping centre, Westgate, which opened in November 2009.

"I am a great fan of the integrated design approach which is the embodiment of ATP's architectural philosophy", explained Travas. "My aim for the future is to incorporate as many new client-focussed features as possible into our design process".
