# Michael Hiss Managing Director for Building Technology at ATP N+M Frankfurt

**Michael Hiss** was born in 1971 in Flörsheim am Main and studied architecture at the Technical University in Darmstadt. His first professional experience was during his studies when he spent time working as a site engineer for **Hochtief AG** at the New Athens International Airport. After this time spent "at the other end of the design process", Hiss joined the competition and project development group of **Novotny Mähner Architects** in Frankfurt in 1998. In 2000 he became an associate and gained special responsibility as the Head of Construction Management for the design and realisation of such large projects as Dresdner Bank's "Galileo" tower in Frankfurt. In 2004 Hiss switched to the client side as project leader of the LAC-Lufthansa Aviation Centre at Frankfurt/Main airport. Most recently he was active as the head of strategic purchasing of construction services with special responsibility for the commissioning by **Deutsche Lufthansa AG** of controlling, design, execution, facilities management and energy services. In the management team of **ATP N+M Frankfurt**, Hiss will have particular responsibility for the various fields of engineering as well as for the areas of controlling, personnel and organisation.

Hiss on ATP: "The attraction and added value of ATP come from the way in which architects and engineers work side by side to find integrated solutions for their clients. In this way we are borrowing a leaf from the work of the very first master builders".

#### A SHORT HISTORY OF ATP N+M ARCHITECTS AND ENGINEERS

In 1959 Dipl.-Ing. Architekt Fritz Novotny and Dipl.-Ing. Architekt Arthur Mähner established the architectural office "Novotny Mähner" in Offenbach, which went on to become very well known for a number of successes in competitions for high rise buildings. Many of these towers were built in Frankfurt and have a prominent place of the skyline of the city (Hessische Landesbank, Trianon, American Express, TaunusTower, Eurotheum, Galileo, Main Triangel). NMA is also known across Europe for its work in the areas of hospitals.

In 1999 the architect Ulf Bambach joined the company, going on to become a managing director in 2003. A cooperation agreement with ATP Architects and Engineers was established in 2005. In 2009 N+M became a member of the ATP Group with Ulf Bambach becoming the first German partner of ATP Architects and Engineers. In 2010 he was joined by Michael Hiss as second managing director.
