Architect of the Year 2011

ATP-CEO Christoph M. Achammer accepted the title of "Architect of the Year 2011" on behalf of the more than 450 architects and engineers of ATP Architects and Engineers on the occasion of the ATGA Facility Congress.

Vienna, 24th May 2011 - **Professor Christoph M. Achammer** was named **Architect of the Year** on the occasion of the **ATGA Facility Congress**. The **ATGA prize** is awarded to architects whose work “best fulfils the requirements of architectural design, functionality and building operations. ...

The objective of the prize is to promote not only a unified approach to issues of architectural design and functionality in the daily use and operations of a building but also the communication and further development of shared ideas and processes in this area, as well as to reward work which pioneers such an approach” (ATGA)

Architect Achammer accepted the prize on behalf of his entire team and emphasised **that the the integrated design approach perfected over more than 30 years by ATP’s own architects and engineers is an essential requirement for the design of sustainable buildings.**

“The idealised academic notion of an integrated design process can rarely be implemented in reality. This is influenced and modified as a result of the interaction with a series of design partners who represent the various interests involved in a design process. And yet the basis for sustainable real estate management is the integrated design of buildings.

Professor Achammer has been pursuing this ideology since the 1970s” This argument distinguished him from all other nominations and resulted in his nomination as the Architect of the Year 2011.”
